4. Big Dam Bridge, Little Rock side to Old State House Museum

5. Parking lot at Barrow and Markham to the Old State House Museum

7. US Pizza – Heights location to the Old State House Museum

bike trail through Allsopp Park. Cross Cantrell on Cedar Hill and make a right on Rebsamen Park Road. Continue past Dixie Café and make a left on unnamed street which leads through the parking lots of Office Depot, Whole Hog, Walmart, etc. Make a left on Riverfront Drive and an immediate right on Jessie Road before joining the Titus Trail to your right. Continue along the Arkansas River Trail on Cantrell, in front of Dillard's and Episcopal Collegiate School.
